
Welcome to the Long Gallery!

More than two hundred works of art are displayed here, spanning the sixteenth to the twentieth centuries. They are hung floor to ceiling so that we can show as much of the museum's collection as possible. Each wall explores a subject (such as horses, birds, music, or landscape) or a place — not only Britain but also America, India, and Italy. These groupings show surprising connections and comparisons between works made over the course of several centuries.

Most of the works in the Long Gallery were given to the museum by its founder, Paul Mellon (1907–1999; Yale College, Class of 1929), who assembled the largest collection of British art outside of Britain.








